**EMISSION CONSENT ORDER**

With reference to the application dated: **02.07.2015** of **M/s Sona Sati Organics Pvt. Ltd., Rajapatti Kothi, Baikunthpur, Gopalganj** for consent under sections 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, he/they is/are granted consent to operate his/their plant at **Rajapatti Kothi, Baikunthpur, Gopalganj** for the period from **01.10.2015** to **30.09.2018** with the following conditions:-

- 1 That, he/they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 22,23 and 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 24,25 and 26 of the Act ;
- 2 That, he /they shall comply with the requirements of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; rules 4,5,7,9,10 and 11 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling), Rules 1989; rules 4,5,7,8,10,11,12,13,15,17 and 18 of the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989; and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991, whichever is applicable;
- 3 That, he/they shall monitor his/their emission(s) and the ambient air quality from representative point regularly and shall maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
- 4 That, he/they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent i.e. **31.08.2015** or within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, whichever is applicable.
- 5 That, installation of online emission monitoring system and connectivity with SPCB/CPCB shall be completed strictly before as against submission in their affidavit dated: 13.10.2015/6.10.2015; otherwise, this consent order shall be assumed to be revoked automatically
- 6 That, in the event of any direction, otherwise, from CPCB, the unit shall be bound by the terms of that direction.
- 7 That, ambient air quality and stack monitoring (including noise) shall be carried out regularly as per CPCB norms (Emission Standards Part-III)/under the Rules/EC and reports shall be submitted to the Board & MoEF & CC, accordingly.
- 8 That, they shall comply with the quality of emissions & provisions as prescribed under the Rules;
- 9 That, they shall comply with conditions of EC issued vide ref. dated 08.06.2007 and amendment in EC dated 13.04.2009, Govt. of India as well as any directions issued earlier either by SPCB/CPCB;
- 10 That, proper management of fermentation house, no longer retention of fermented wash etc to avoid generation of putrefying micro-organism shall be practiced to control odour problems;
- 11 Environmental Statement for the each financial year shall be submitted to the Board by the end of Sept.
- 12 Maintenance & look-after of manufacturing plant/machinery/vehicles etc will be done in a sustainable manner to ensure best performance and less noise; and
- 13 That, green belt of adequate width and density in at least 33% of the total area shall be developed as per the CPCB guidelines in consultation with the local DFO.

**DISCHARGE CONSENT ORDER**

With reference to the application dated: 29.5.2015 of M/s Sona Sati Organics Pvt. Ltd., Rajapatti Kothi, Baikunthpur, Gopalganj for consent under sections 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, he/they is/are granted consent to bring into use his/their new/alterd/existing outlet(s) for discharge of trade effluent and/or domestic sewage at Rajapatti Kothi, Baikunthpur, Gopalganj for the period from 1.10.2015 to 30.09.2018 subject to the following conditions:-

- 1 That, he/they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 24,31 and 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,1974 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 20,21,23,30 and 32 of the Act;
- 2 That, he /they shall comply with the requirements of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; rules 4,5,7,9,10 and 11 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling), Rules 1989, rules 4,5,7,8,10,11,12,13,15 and 18 of the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules,1989; and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act,1991, whichever is applicable;
- 3 That, he/they shall monitor his/their effluent(s) regularly and maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
- 4 That, he/they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent i.e 31.08.2018 or within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, whichever is applicable.
- 5 That, discharge of any industrial or domestic effluent shall not be allowed in any case and they shall have to ensure the zero discharge. In case of any uneven situation plant shall be shutdown to maintain zero discharge as well as the operation of distillery shall be as recommended in EC.
- 6 The installed surveillance system (IP Camera) with flow meter shall be connected to SPCB/CPCB server at earliest and status shall be reported to the Board;
- 7 That, the unit may abstract 960m<sup>3</sup>/day of ground water(not exceeding 307,200 m<sup>3</sup>/year)through two(2) bore-wells, only one(1) tube-well to be kept as standby and comply with as directed by CGWA, Ministry of Water Resources, Govt. of India vide ref. CGWA/IND/Proj/2012-1195,dated:23.04.2012 with submission of reports;
- 8 That, they shall comply with provisions under the Rules, conditions of EC issued vide ref. dated: 08.06.2007 and amendment in EC dated: 13.04.2009, Govt. of India as well as any directions issued either by SPCB/CPCB. Reports shall be submitted to the Board also;
- 9 That, they shall adopt rainwater harvesting measures to recharge the ground water and proper records shall be maintained;
- 10 That, the unit shall establish flow measuring devices to assess water consumptions, spent wash generation and its quantity before and after treatment etc;
- 11 Efforts would be made to conserve as much water as possible by recycling and reusing. Record of waste-water returned back to process for utilization in liquefaction/fermentation/cooling would be kept (both quantity and quality details); and
- 12 Environmental Statement for the each financial year shall be submitted to the Board by the end of Sept.
- 13 That, in the event of any direction, otherwise, from CPCB, the unit shall be bound by the terms of that direction.
